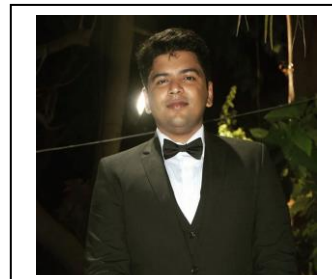
Supplementary Information
