Gender Sensitive Media in South Asia

Looking at the growing importance of inclusive development approach, women and girls have been at the centre of development debate in South Asia over the years and the importance of gender sensitisation of media on this issue has been a matter of concern for the entire region. But media has not been very active in reporting news centring gender aspects. During CUTS Media Mapping exercise it was noted that very few information was available on women oriented news in SDIP focus domains while plenty of general news is available in issues related to food, water & energy, regional cooperation, etc. It was also noted that newspapers in the North-eastern region of India like The Assam Tribune, The Sentinel etc. have been writing news reports on gender and social issues more as compared to other Indian dailies. This is quite evident from the fact that women in NE Indian States of Brahmaputra are more empowered than in other parts of India and Bangladesh.

Mainstreaming gender and social issues in the development process depends upon the attention given to these issues by the government and other development agencies. Of all the three river basins, women in the Indian part of Brahmaputra basin are more progressive and consequently media has played an integral part in advocating developments related to gender and social inclusion issues. In all the other river basins, limited attention is currently given to issues of gender and social inclusion and hence, the media is also not paying more heed to these issues and its role is quite limited.

Considering the pertinence of media sensitisation on gender and social inclusion issue, CUTS plan to conduct local, national and regional media sensitisation workshops in all the five project countries during 2015 and 2016. To make this exercise more inclusive and impactful, CUTS will take help from all of its strategic partners. A strong association with print and electronic media is expected to lead to an effective dissemination of the research findings, stimulate policy debate, promote endorsement of research findings, and create conducive environment for the necessary policy and practice changes in SDIP domains of change.

In our upcoming perception survey, CUTS will map stakeholders' perception on pre-identified issues and their expected solutions. Based on stakeholder interviews and focus group discussions, the perception study will analyse what people think as key challenges in their region (with an emphasis on the gender and social inclusion aspects) and what could be a solution and weigh that vis-à-vis the technical solutions being considered at the policy level. Gender oriented messages as analysed from our study will be advocated to various stakeholders, Media being one. Eventually, CUTS will organise capacity building workshops with the Media with an objective to make this fraternity more gender aware and friendly.
