Women's participation in trade and trade-related activities in Bangladesh, Bhutan, India and Nepal (BBIN) is an issue that needs special attention in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic as micro, small and medium enterprises are bearing the brunt of the crises.

Similarly, the closure of international borders, shutting down production units, travel restrictions and sluggish demand due to the Covid-19 outbreak has impacted women and women entrepreneurs engaged in cross-border formal and informal land trade.

The pandemic has also resulted in the closure of 'Border Haats' that are functional along the international border between India and Bangladesh; thereby cutting off an easier source of consumer goods to marginalised communities, particularly women.
