WTO MC14 OUTCOMES AND THE FUTURE OF THE MULTILATERAL TRADING SYSTEM

The recent 14th Ministerial Conference (MC14) of the World Trade Organization marked a critical moment for the multilateral trading system, yet fell short of delivering substantive outcomes. This has prompted important question on the direction, relevance, and future trajectory of the WTO.

Considering these developments, CUTS International and Chintan Research Foundation (CRF), is convening a roundtable to reflect on the implications of MC14 and assess the way forward. The discussion will examine whether the outcome represents a temporary pause or a deeper structural challenge to the multilateral system.
